WHAT KINDS OF SCHOLARSHIPS ARE OUT THERE?

With nearly 200 scholarships listed in this guide, chances are you can find one that suits your interests, achievements, circumstances, county of residence, and anticipated major.

Artists might look into the Arts for Life! Scholarship, which awards 25 students a \$1,000 scholarship each. Florida high school students involved in creative writing, dance, drama, music, or the visual arts can apply for this scholarship.

Are you an athlete who lives in Lee County? Consider the Tommy Bohanon Foundation Scholarship, which awards \$10,000 to students who can prove participation in any sport during high school.

The ExxonMobil Engineering Scholarship Program gives one 4-year \$20,000 national scholarship and twelve 1-year \$2,000 local scholarships to outstanding Hispanic high school seniors who plan to pursue a degree in engineering.

Doctors, nurses, engineers, business leaders, peanut farmers, amateur ham radio enthusiasts, and so many others are eligible for scholarships! There are scholarships based on where your parents work, where your grandparents came from, what faith or religion you practice, whether you are financially disadvantaged, your GPA, where you volunteer your time, if your parents are divorced, and many more criteria.

FGSA Scholarship

FSGA Scholars is a scholarship program made possible by the Florida State Golf Association and our Future of Golf Foundation. In the Spring each year, the FSGA selects a minimum of five golfers from the FJT's graduating class to be awarded a renewable four-year scholarship. A total of \$10,000 in college scholarships will be awarded each year, resulting in \$40,000 granted to each graduating class. Each scholarship is awarded on a two-semester term (fall & spring). Payment of the scholarship is made in two installments to the college or university the student is attending. The first payment is made during the fall semester, and the second payment is made during the spring semester. The Scholarship Committee reviews each renewal every year. A GPA of 3.0 or higher, a brief letter detailing the recent school year and additional information are used in the renewal determination process. The brief letter (or email) should focus on two points; what was the best part of the previous school year, and what was the worst part and what did you learn.

- A full-time student during the award period (Fall 2020) pursuing a career in journalism
- A minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0

Applications must include the following:

- Scholarship Application
- Copy of Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).
- Copies of all transcripts from institutions in which you have taken courses
- An essay of up to 500 words about your career goals and reasons for choosing the profession
- At least one letter of recommendation
- Any other supporting documentation-such as, resume, relevant coursework, samples of your abilities, accomplishments, etc.

Each year, the Ford Salute to Education program awards 56 Florida scholarships to students in Miami-Dade County and 56 to Students in Broward County with a scholarship worth \$1,500 as well as a laptop computer. Students can apply for a variety of different categories, including athletics, leadership service, sciences, visual arts, and more. Senior high school students residing in and attending accredited schools in San Diego County may apply for one San Diego County Salute to Education scholarship.



Jesse B. Smith Memorial Scholarship

Jesse B. Smith was a longtime point man for Jacksonville's economic development initiatives under four mayors.

The most notable work of this outstanding public official took place during his appointment as Deputy Director of the Planning and Development Department of the city from 1990-1995. During this time, he was a key organizer of many of the city's efforts to attract new businesses and was very successful in obtaining state and federal assistance.

Each year, the Jesse B. Smith Memorial Scholarship is awarded to students planning to study city planning, urban studies, public administration, or a related field. Students who are residents of Duval County or Jacksonville are eligible to apply.



Friends of 440 Scholarship

The purpose of Friends of 440 Scholarship Fund is to aid dependents or descendants of workers who were injured or killed in the course and scope of their employment and who received benefits under the Florida Workers' Compensation Law. In addition, dependents of individuals who primarily work in the operation and/or administration of this same law are eligible to receive scholarships.

Scholarships are intended to assist students who meet this criteria and lack the economic ability to continue education beyond high school or to further their college education.



ESA Youth Scholarship

- A student attending (or planning to attend) a Florida college or university
 - A full-time student during the award period (Fall 2020) pursuing a career in journalism
 - A minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0

Arts for Life! annually awards \$1,000 scholarships to 25 graduating high school seniors in Florida who demonstrate excellence in creative writing, dance, drama, music or visual art. Launched by former First Lady Columba Bush in 1999, the program has awarded scholarships to more than 500 gifted high school seniors. This application is available to students in public, private, and online schools or to students who are homeschooled in the state of Florida.



Barbara L. Frye Scholarship

The scholarship is available to students who are attending or planning on attending school in the state or who have graduated from a Florida high school.

Graduating high school seniors and college students planning to pursue a career in journalism can apply for scholarship awards up to \$2,000. Students who attend or attended a high school in Florida or attend or expect to attend a college or university in Florida are eligible to apply, including graduate students. Applicants must either be students scheduled to graduate from high school during the 2020-21 academic year, full-time college students working toward an undergraduate degree or students enrolled in a graduate-level program with the intent of honing journalistic skills. Applicants don't have to be majoring in journalism, but they must have an expressed interest in a career in journalism and be working toward that goal.

Florida high school students who wish to qualify for the Florida Medallion Scholars (FMS) award must meet the following initial eligibility requirements:

- Graduate high school from a Florida public high school with a standard Florida high school diploma (high school graduation requirements), graduate from a registered Florida Department of Education private high school, earn a GED, complete a home education program, or graduate from a non-Florida high school (OOS);
 - Complete the required high school coursework;
 - Achieve the required minimum high school grade point average (GPA);
 - Achieve the required minimum score on either the ACT® or SAT® college entrance exam; and
 - Complete the required number of service hours.

- Graduate high school from a Florida public high school with a standard Florida high school diploma (high school graduation requirements), graduate from a registered Florida Department of Education private high school, earn a GED, complete a home education program, or graduate from a non-Florida high school (OOS);
 - Complete the required high school coursework;
 - Achieve the required minimum high school grade point average (GPA);
 - Achieve the required minimum score on either the ACT® or SAT® college entrance exam; and
 - Complete the required number of service hours.

Florida Gold Seal CAPE Scholarship (GSC)

The Florida Gold Seal CAPE Scholars award (GSC) may be funded if a student is enrolled in a career education or certificate program. Upon completion of an associate in science degree program that articulates to a Bachelor of Science degree, a GSC Scholar may also receive an award for a maximum of 60 credit hours toward a Bachelor of Science degree program. Upon completion of an associate in applied science program, a GSC Scholar may also receive an award for a maximum of 60 credit hours toward a bachelor of applied science degree program.

Florida high school students who wish to qualify for the GSC award must meet the following initial eligibility requirements:

- Earn a minimum of five postsecondary credit hours through CAPE industry certifications that articulate for college credit; and
 - Complete 30 service hours (Students must complete service hours during high school and by high school graduation).

Florida Gold Seal Vocational Scholarship (GSV)

The Florida Gold Seal Vocational Scholars (GSV) award may be funded if a student is enrolled in a career education or certificate program. Florida high school students who wish to qualify for the GSV award must meet the following initial eligibility requirements:

- Achieve the required weighted minimum 3.0 GPA in the non-elective high school courses;
 - Take at least 3 full credits in a single Career and Technical Education program;
 - Achieve the required minimum 3.5 unweighted GPA in the career education courses;
 - Achieve the required minimum score on the ACT®, SAT® or Florida Postsecondary Education Readiness Test (P.E.R.T.) exams; and
 - Complete 30 service hours.

Benacquisto Scholarship Program

The Benacquisto Scholarship Program is a merit scholarship for high school graduates who receive recognition as a National Merit® Scholar. An initial application is not required.

The Give Kids a Chance Scholarship was established by Brian McDonough, Esq. to support children of lower-income families. Scholarships are awarded to high school seniors desiring to continue their education but need additional financial assistance to do so. Recipients are eligible for additional awards given they maintain full-time status and meet academic requirements.

To be eligible for a scholarship, you must have the following criteria:

- Be a graduating senior from a public high school.
 - Be a Florida resident.
 - Have a minimum of a 2.5 GPA.
 - Demonstrate financial need. Eligible students must have a family income that is less than 60% of the median family income of the area in which they reside.
 - Demonstrate an interest in pursuing higher education.
 - Show involvement in school or community activities.
 - Two letters of recommendation from teachers or other community representatives.

District recipients receive US\$1,500, and 10 international recipients are selected from the district/region recipients to receive awards of US\$4,000 each.

Jim came from a family with a tradition of farming and service to country. His great, great-grandfather began raising sugar cane and tobacco in Florida in the early 1800s. His grandfather, Amos, was a member of the FL House of Representatives for seven terms and served as its sergeant-at-arms. Jim's father, Jefferson Davis, brought his family to settle in Homestead after WWII, and purchased a potato farm. In 1978, Jim decided to grow trees on his property – the Davis Tree Farm was born. He died in 1995, but left a legacy for students wanting to pursue their dream in the field of horticulture/agriculture.

- Graduating high school senior from any Palm Beach or Martin County high school. Also open to seniors from homestead and South Dade high school in Dade County, FL.
- Must have a GPA of a 2.0 or better.
- Must attend a Florida private or public college or university.
- Must major in horticulture, environmental horticulture, turf grass, forestry, agriculture, or other agriculture science dealing with the production and management of plants.
