- Ardris Paige Memorial Scholarship- 1@ \$500 BCHS Senior with a minimum of 2.5 GPA, African American Student with college or military acceptance.
- Baker County Community Service Scholarship- 3@ \$1,000 Sponsored by Rack Up Thrift Store Open to all BCHS Seniors with a minimum of 300 community service hours.
- 3) Baker County Education Association Career Start Up Scholarship 1@ \$300 Open to all BCHS Seniors with a minimum of 2.5 GPA, 25 community service hours and must plan to go directly to military or career path upon graduating. Preference will be given to children of BCEA/BCESP members, but not a requirement for application.
