Presentation by the Florida Tobacco Cessation Alliance: Gold Level Worksite Wellness Award

Representatives from the Florida Tobacco Cessation Alliance presented Superintendent Sherrie Raulerson with a Gold Level Worksite Wellness Award for the Baker County School District.
