Upon returning to the Baker County Public Schools, **Baker County High School student case** #031820135153915 must re-enter through the alternative school setting at Baker County High School for a minimum of forty-five (45) days. As recommended by Superintendent Raulerson, Patricia Weeks made a motion to approve, seconded by Artie Burnett. The motion carried 4-0.
