Upon returning to the Baker County Public Schools, Baker County High School student case #102120195155092 must re-enter through the Baker County CATS Academy alternative school setting for a minimum of forty-five (45) days. As recommended by Superintendent Raulerson, Patricia Weeks made a motion to approve, seconded by Paula Barton. The motion carried 5-0.
