Superintendent Raulerson (259-0401)

Superintendent Raulerson presented Baker County High School with their Florida Department of Education's School Volunteer Program certificates for both the Golden School Award, which is based on their adult volunteer hours, and the Silver School Award, which is based on their student volunteer hours.
